## **Old Bridal Path**

July 21-24 & July 28-31

**Project Summary & Goals:** The crew is working on three different relocation sections cutting tread and building structures to create sustainable trail. This will allow steep, eroded sections of trail to be decommissioned. The crew has been working to finish the first relocation section and connect it to the existing trail. The crew has been joined by the Northwoods partner crew who have aided the progress greatly.

**Successes:** The first relocation section was connected to the existing trail and finishing work was continued. A section of the trail was crush hardened and a retaining wall was built on the lower section. Additionally, a highline was set up and the Northwoods crew was trained in the highline operation. They were able to move 27 stones to the second relocation area.
